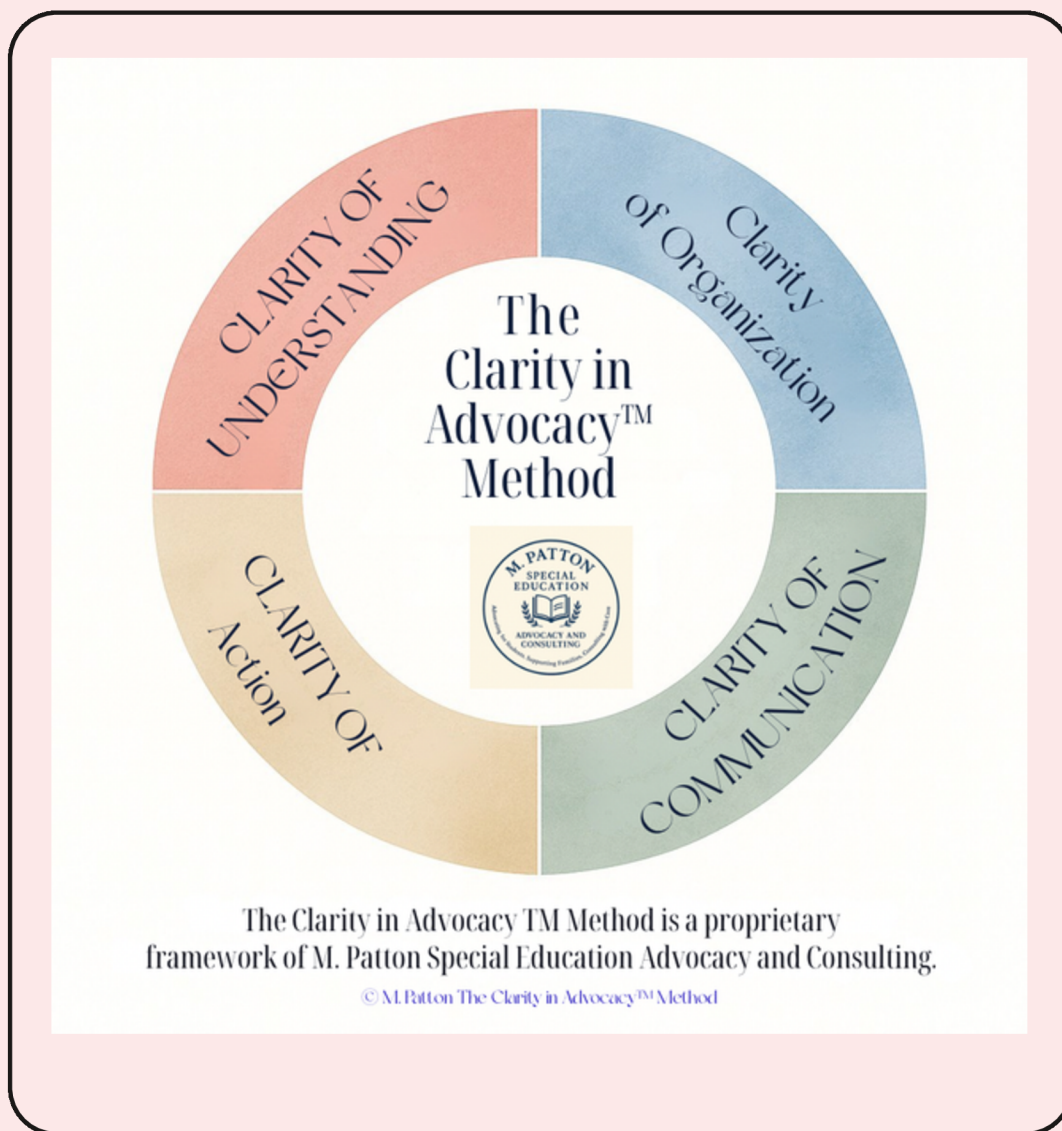

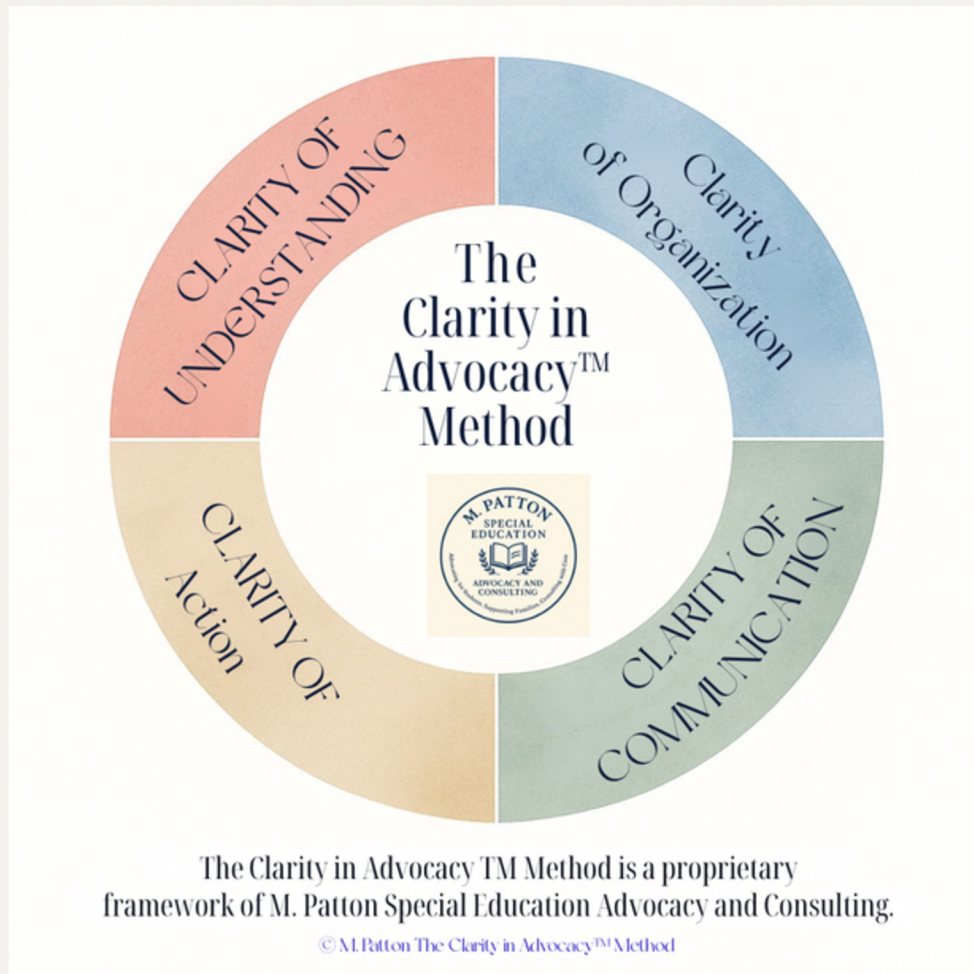

**At the base of every effective advocate is emotional regulation and clarity. The C.A.L.M.**

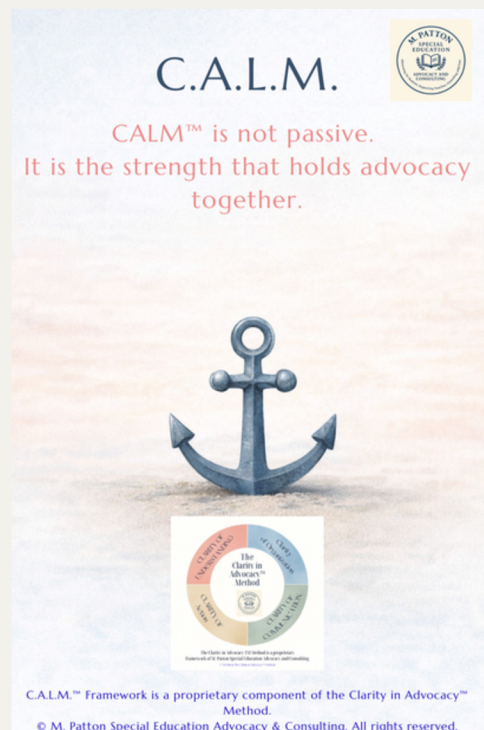
**Framework teaches parents how to approach advocacy with steadiness, compassion, and mindfulness.**

**C – Center your emotions before responding.**

**A – Acknowledge your triggers and set your intention.**

**L – Lead with purpose and professionalism.**

**M – Maintain steady energy and composure throughout the process.**



## Applying The Clarity in Advocacy Method Framework:

Many parents begin advocacy by taking action first. The Clarity in Advocacy™ Method takes a different approach.

Effective advocacy begins with a strong foundation.

Parents are encouraged to first develop:

1. Clarity of Understanding — Learn the system, your rights, and your child's educational needs.
2. Clarity of Organization — Organize records, data, and documentation to support informed decision-making.
3. Clarity of Communication — Communicate clearly, professionally, and purposefully with school teams.
4. Clarity of Action — Take informed steps based on knowledge, preparation, and effective communication.
